IfModule mod_userdir.c>
```

UserDir enabled user1
```

```
UserDir disabled user1
```

```
UserDir public_html
```

The web server URL is <http://host01>.

A website exists in the user's directory /home/user1/public_html.

A user attempts to access user's webpages by using the URL: http://host01/~user1

Which statement describes the outcome?

- A. The occurrence of user1 in the list of disabled users causes an access denied error to the website contained in user's public_html subdirectory, overriding the enabled directive.
