QUESTION 4

Pushing in the trailer air supply knob will do what?

- A. Supply air to the service air line
- B. Supply air to the emergency air line
- C. Shut off air to the trailer air tank

Correct Answer: B

The correct answer is: Supply air to the emergency air line. The trailer air supply control knob is used to control the tractor protection valve. You push the knob in to supply the trailer with air (via the emergency air line) and pull it out to shut off the air and put on the trailer emergency brakes.

QUESTION 5

The two-inch line on the floor behind the driver's seat is known as

- A. Stand zone
- B. Driver area line
- C. Baggage line
- D. Standee line

Correct Answer: D

The correct answer is: Standee line. Riders are not allowed to stand forward of the rear of the driver's seat. Buses that allow standing must have a "standee line" (two-inch line on the floor behind the driver's seat) to show passengers where they cannot stand.

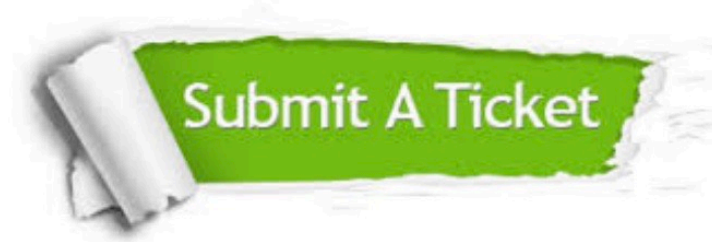
