    onView(withText("Hello Steve!")).check(matches(isDisplayed()))  
}
```

C. @Test

```
fun greeterSaysHello() {  
    onView(withId(R.id.name_field)).do(typeText("Steve"))  
    onView(withId(R.id.greet_button)).do(click())  
    onView(withText("Hello Steve!")).compare(matches(isDisplayed()))  
}
```

    public void insertUsers(User... users);}
```
