Capacity Threshold Warnings: 80% of user capacity = warning, start planning for expansion or cleanup 95% user capacity is the health check warning, new backups are suspended 100% user capacity makes the Avamar read-only, can still restore from server 85% of OS capacity = Garbage collection stops running, utilization increases rapidly 90% OS capacity = HFS checks stop running 96% OS capacity = no more checkpoints

## QUESTION 5

During EMC Avamar garbage collection, which backups are candidates for deletion?

- A. Backups that failed HFS check
- B. Backups that were replicated to Data Domain

Correct Answer: D

For initial backup of Avamar clients, it's best to start with a small number of clients to produce a dataset from which commonality will be generated. This will increase the backup speed of following clients. On a new Avamar system, consider enabling overtime because all the data is new and there won't be much maintenance to take place. Never enable overtime on an existing Avamar, rather configure the use of partial backups to be saved. Partial backups are saved for 7 days and are not deleted by the garbage collection process. When an unfinished job ends before completing and partial backups are enabled, the backup job will continue from the last known state and will complete faster.
